STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS 14984C1

Suicide is the second leading cause of death in the 15-24 year age groups with Idaho being consistently among the states having the highest rates. Our teachers and school personnel are a major part of our children's day when they are in school. It is important that these educators be knowledgeable and prepared, as much as possible, about the risk factors, the protective factors and the suicide warning signs so professionals can be alerted.

This resolution asks that the education departments at our college and universities do what they can to prepare our teachers to recognize the signs of suicide and to alert the proper professionals.
